Adjusts expenditure limitations for State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology for biennium ending June 30, 2007. Declarge emergency effective [July 1, 2007] on passage

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$78,616
6	is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of
7	expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
8	cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Board of Examiners of
9	Licensed Dietitians.
10	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
11	\$1,064,292 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for
12	payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
13	but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Mortuary
14	and Cemetery Board.
15	SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$400,576
16	is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of
17	expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
18	cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Board of Naturopathic
19	Examiners.
20	SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$200,249
21	is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of

2 <u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$290,133 3 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of 4 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-5 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Occupational Therapy 6 Licensing Board.

SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$529,670
is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of
expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Board of Radiologic
Technology.

12 <u>SECTION 7.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$290,732 13 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of 14 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-15 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Board of Examin-16 ers for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology.

17 <u>SECTION 8.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$545,131 18 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of 19 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-20 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon State Veterinary 21 Medical Examining Board.

22 <u>SECTION 9.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the State Board of 23 Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology for the payment of expenses of the 24 board from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding 25 lottery funds and federal funds, for the biennium ending June 30, 2007, the limitation on 26 expenditures for the State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology 27 established by section 8, chapter 606, Oregon Laws 2005, as modified by Emergency Board 28 action, is increased by \$17,000.

29 <u>SECTION 10.</u> This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 30 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect 31 on its passage.

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
