## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Allows jurisdiction to operate photo radar in highway work zone. Sunsets December 31, 2014.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to photo radar in highway work zone. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle 4 Code. 5 6 SECTION 2. (1) Any jurisdiction may, at their own cost, operate photo radar in a highway work zone, as defined in ORS 811.230. 7 8 (2) A photo radar system operated under this section may not be used unless a sign is posted announcing that photo radar is in use. The sign posted under this subsection must 9 be all of the following: 10 (a) On the street on which the photo radar unit is being used. 11 12 (b) Between 100 and 400 yards before the location of the photo radar unit. (3) A jurisdiction that operates a photo radar system under this section shall, once each 13biennium, conduct a process and outcome evaluation for the purposes of subsection (4) of 14 this section that includes: 15(a) The effect of the use of the photo radar system on traffic safety; 16 17 (b) The degree of public acceptance of the use of the photo radar system; and (c) The process of administration of the use of the photo radar system. 18 (4) By March 1 of the year of each regular session of the Legislative Assembly: 19 20 (a) The Department of Transportation shall provide to the Legislative Assembly an 21executive summary of the process and outcome evaluations conducted under subsection (3) 22of this section; and (b) Each jurisdiction that operates a photo radar system under this section shall present 23 24 to the Legislative Assembly the process and outcome evaluation conducted by the jurisdic-25tion under subsection (3) of this section. SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is repealed on December 31, 2014. 2627
