

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 432

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND OCEAN POLICY

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 20, insert:

2 “(g) ‘Ship’ means a vessel that weighs in excess of 200 tons and operates upon navigable
3 waterways.”

4 In line 21, delete “(g)” and insert “(h)”.

5 Delete line 22 and insert:

6 “(i) ‘Shipwreck’ means a ship that has been stranded or destroyed by being driven ashore or
7 onto the rocks or the shoal.

8 “(j) ‘Waters of this state’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 196.800.”

9 In line 25, delete “Oregon’s territorial sea” and insert “the waters of this state”.

10 In line 29, delete “vessel to enter Oregon’s territorial sea” and insert “ship to enter the waters
11 of this state”.

12 After line 29, insert:

13 “(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2) of this section, a person may in the waters of this state
14 dismantle for removal a ship that has been shipwrecked if the Department of State Lands determines
15 that it is physically impracticable to move the shipwreck to a dry dock.”
