SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 545

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "432.005" and insert "692.045".
- 2 Delete lines 5 through 31.
- 3 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 27.
- 4 In line 28, delete "2" and insert "1".
- 5 In line 44, delete "3" and insert "2".
- 6 On page 3, delete lines 13 through 20 and insert:

"(5) A person may serve as a funeral service practitioner apprentice for an aggregate total of not more than 48 months. In computing time under this subsection, the board shall exclude time lost by interruptions caused by active duty of the apprentice in the military service of the United States or its allies during war or national emergency and by interruptions that the board finds are excusable under rules of the board.".

12 In line 23, after "(7)" delete the rest of the line and line 24.

13 In line 25, delete the period.

14 Delete lines 30 through 44 and insert:

15 "(8) Notwithstanding subsections (2) and (3) of this section, a licensed funeral service practitioner or a licensed embalmer may serve as a preceptor for not more than three students serving a funeral service internship in accordance with guidelines established by an accredited funeral service education program.".

19 In line 45, delete "(8)" and insert "(9)".

20 On page 4, after line 3, insert:

21 "SECTION 3. ORS 692.045 is amended to read:

"692.045. (1) The State Mortuary and Cemetery Board shall issue a license to an individual to practice as a funeral service practitioner if the individual meets the following requirements:

24 "(a) The individual must apply to the board for a funeral service practitioner's license on an 25 application form provided by the board.

26 "(b) The individual must pass an examination conducted by the board under ORS 692.070 fol-27 lowing application for the funeral service practitioner's license.

28 "(c) The individual must successfully complete practical experience as a funeral service practi-29 tioner's apprentice under ORS 692.190.

30 "(2) An individual may not take an examination under ORS 692.070 until the individual has 31 provided written evidence of graduation from an associate degree program meeting the requirements 32 established by board rule.

33 "(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2) of this section, an applicant with four years of experience 34 as a licensed funeral service practitioner or embalmer **in this state or** in another state is not re-35 quired to provide written evidence of graduation from an associate degree program in order to take 1 the examination under ORS 692.070.".
