SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Human Services for psychiatric day treatment for eastern Oregon children.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to mental health care for children in eastern Oregon; appropriating money; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
6 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of**
7 **the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ , which may be expended for providing psychiatric**
8 **day treatment at Pendleton Academies in Umatilla County to eastern Oregon children who**
9 **are at least six years of age and less than 18 years of age.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
12 **July 1, 2007.**
