

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 630

By COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATIVE OPERATIONS AND REFORM

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete line 7 and insert:

2 “(2) Subject to subsection (5) of this section and the provisions of a home rule charter, for voter
3 choice offices, the two candi-”.

4 After line 16, insert:

5 “(5) When a candidate for voter choice office receives a majority of the votes cast for the office
6 at the primary election, that candidate’s name shall be the only one printed for that office on the
7 ballot for the general election.”.

8 On page 18, after line 29, insert:

9 “(3) Not later than the 90th day before the date of the primary election, a political party shall
10 file with the Secretary of State a certified copy of the current party rule specifying qualifications
11 that a candidate must satisfy to be eligible to be listed on the ballot as a member of the political
12 party. Not later than the 63rd day before the date of the primary election, a political party may
13 notify the chief elections officer that a candidate for nomination to a voter choice office has been
14 determined by the party to be ineligible to be listed on the ballot as a member of the political party
15 in accordance with party rules.”.

16 In line 30, delete “(3)” and insert “(4)”.

17 In line 34, delete “(4)” and insert “(5)”.

18 In line 39, delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.
