## Senate Bill 676

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits insurer from refusing claim on basis that claim was submitted by physician assistant rather than by supervising physician. Repeals sunset provision.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to payment of claims submitted by physician assistants; amending ORS 743.725; and re-

3 pealing section 2, chapter 446, Oregon Laws 2003.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 743.725 is amended to read:

6 743.725. (1) [No insurer shall] An insurer may not refuse a claim solely on the ground that the

7 claim was submitted by a physician assistant [practicing under the circumstances set forth in ORS

8 677.515 (4)] rather than by the supervising physician for the physician assistant.

9 (2) This section is exempt from ORS 743.700.

10 SECTION 2. Section 2, chapter 446, Oregon Laws 2003, is repealed.

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
