Delete lines 4 to 27 of the printed bill and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: 3 "(a) 'Pig' means a porcine animal of a type maintained as livestock. "(b) 'Turning around freely' means having the ability to turn in a complete circle in an 4 $\mathbf{5}$ enclosure without an impediment, including a tether, and without touching any side of the 6 enclosure. "(2) A person commits the offense of restrictive confinement of a pregnant pig if the 7 person confines a pregnant pig for more than 12 hours during any 24-hour period in a manner 8 9 that prevents the pregnant pig from: 10 "(a) Lying down and fully extending its limbs; or 11 "(b) Turning around freely. 12"(3) Subsection (2) of this section does not apply to a pregnant pig: 13 "(a) That is being transported; 14 "(b) In a rodeo exhibition, a state or county fair exhibition or a similar exhibition; "(c) During the slaughtering process; 15 16 "(d) During lawful scientific or agricultural research; 17 "(e) During an examination, operation or test by a veterinarian or during temporary 18 treatment for veterinary purposes; or 19 "(f) In the seven-day period before the pig farrows. 20 "(4) The offense of restrictive confinement of a pregnant pig is a Class A misdemeanor. 21"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act applies to confinement of a pregnant pig that occurs on or after January 1, 2012.". 2223
