Senate Bill 730

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows owner of private parking facility to enter into agreement with towing business to permit towing business to assess fine against owner of motor vehicle in lieu of towing vehicle.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to private parking facility.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 98.810 to 98.818.
5	SECTION 2. (1) The owner of a private parking facility may enter into an agreement with
6	a towing business that allows the towing business to assess a fine against the owner of a
7	motor vehicle parked in violation of ORS 98.810 in lieu of towing the vehicle.
8	(2) To assess a fine against the owner of a vehicle under this section, a towing business
9	shall affix a notice of the fine to the vehicle in a conspicuous place. The notice must include:
10	(a) The name, address and telephone number of the private parking facility owner;
11	(b) A description of the vehicle, including registration plate;
12	(c) The amount of the fine;
13	(d) The date and time that the fine was assessed;
14	(e) The location or address of the private parking facility;
15	(f) Instructions describing the deadlines and methods of payment accepted; and
16	(g) Additional fees, if any, that may be added in case of late payment of the fine.
