On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and insert 1 2 "and appropriating money.". 3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert: "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414. 4 5 "SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Human Services shall provide payment for substance abuse treatment for a person who: 6 7 "(a) Is the parent or legal guardian of a child who has been removed from the parent's or legal guardian's home and accepted for placement and care by the department as a result 8 9 of a judicial determination that continued presence in the parent's or legal guardian's home 10 is contrary to the best interests of the child; 11 "(b) Has a current case plan for reunification that requires the person to receive sub-12stance abuse treatment; and 13 "(c) Is not otherwise eligible for health insurance or a medical assistance program that 14 will provide payment for the required treatment. 15"(2) If the person fails to comply with the requirements of the reunification case plan, 16 the person is ineligible for payment of substance abuse treatment under this section. 17 "(3) The department shall adopt rules necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. 18 "SECTION 3. The Substance Abuse Treatment Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Substance Abuse 19 20 Treatment Fund shall be credited to the fund. Moneys in the fund are continuously appro-21priated to the Department of Human Services to carry out the purposes of section 2 of this 2007 Act.". 2223
