SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Department of Fish and Wildlife to track harvest level of fish species managed pursuant to fishery management plan prepared by regional fishery management council and to notify public of progress toward maximum harvest level.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Pacific marine fishery management plans.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 506.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) In order to provide notice of future closures of fisheries managed pur-

6 suant to a fishery management plan prepared by a regional fishery management council

7 pursuant to the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act, 16 U.S.C.

8 1801 et seq., the State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall:

- 9 (a) During a fishing season for a particular food fish species, track the harvest level of
 10 that species on a daily basis; and
- (b) Provide to the public information relating to the harvest level and the progress to ward meeting the maximum harvest level provided under the fishery management plan for
 that species.

(2) The department may provide the information required by subsection (1) of this section
 via a commonly used, electronic format on the World Wide Web.
