SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Establishes Oregon Declared Emergency Recovery Fund. Specifies purposes of fund. Continuously appropriates moneys in fund to Governor. Directs that moneys in fund be disbursed by Oregon Military Department through Office of Emergency Management. Directs Oregon Military Department to establish review board to identify recipients of moneys from fund and set priorities and amounts to be disbursed. Sets membership of review board. Requires Legislative Assembly to appropriate General Fund moneys and allocate lottery moneys to fund in specified ratio.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Declared Emergency Recovery Fund is established in the
5	State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Oregon
6	Declared Emergency Recovery Fund shall be credited to the Oregon Declared Emergency
7	Recovery Fund.
8	(2) The fund shall consist of:
9	(a) Moneys appropriated by the Legislative Assembly from the General Fund to the
10	Oregon Declared Emergency Recovery Fund;
11	(b) Moneys allocated by the Legislative Assembly from the Administrative Services Eco-
12	nomic Development Fund established by ORS 461.540 to the Oregon Declared Emergency
13	Recovery Fund; and
14	(c) Any other moneys deposited into the fund pursuant to law.
15	(3) Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the Governor for the purposes
16	described in section 2 of this 2008 Act.
17	(4) At the direction of the Governor, moneys in the fund shall be disbursed by the Oregon
18	Military Department through the Office of Emergency Management.
19	(5) At the direction of the Governor, the Oregon Military Department and the Office of
20	Emergency Management shall establish a review board to identify recipients of any loan,
21	grant or funds under section 2 of this 2008 Act and specify the amounts of any loan, grant
22	or funds. The review board may set priorities for identifying recipients and specifying
23	amounts to be disbursed. The review board shall include, but is not limited to:
24	(a) Not more than three members of county governing bodies;

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(b) Not more than three members of city governing bodies; 1 2 (c) A representative of the Economic and Community Development Department; (d) A representative of the Oregon Military Department; 3 (e) A representative of the Office of Emergency Management; and 4 5 (f) A representative of special districts. SECTION 2. (1) Moneys in the Oregon Declared Emergency Recovery Fund established 6 by section 1 of this 2008 Act may be used only for recovery efforts in response to a state of 7 emergency declared by the Governor as provided in ORS 401.055 or by an appropriate federal 8 9 agency. (2) Within the limitation of subsection (1) of this section, moneys in the fund may be used 10 for the following: 11 12(a) Providing loans or grants to local governments, as defined in ORS 174.116, and school 13 districts on such terms and conditions as the Governor deems appropriate. (b) Providing funds to local governments, as defined in ORS 174.116, and school districts 14 15 to be used to match moneys from federal programs for emergency relief that require a match. Moneys provided under this paragraph may be used to supplement moneys provided 16 by local governments or school districts for a required match that exceeds 10 percent of the 17 18 amount of the federal moneys required to be matched. 19 (c) Providing funds to be used by the Department of Human Services for direct aid to 20individuals through existing department programs. (d) Providing funds to be used by the Housing and Community Services Department for 2122direct aid to individuals through existing department programs. 23(e) Providing funds for costs that the Governor determines are appropriate, necessary and urgent for the state's response to a declared state of emergency. 2425SECTION 3. (1) Each biennium, the Legislative Assembly shall appropriate moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Declared Emergency Recovery Fund. Notwithstanding ORS 2627293.190, moneys appropriated from the General Fund to the Oregon Declared Emergency Recovery Fund do not revert to the General Fund. 28(2) Each biennium, the Legislative Assembly shall allocate from the Administrative Ser-2930 vices Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Declared Emergency Recovery Fund an 31 amount equal to three times the amount appropriated pursuant to subsection (1) of this

33 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2008 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 34 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2008 Act takes effect 35 on its passage.

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
