**WHAT THE BILL DOES:** Allows a school district with voter approval of a construction bond greater than \$1 million to change the construction site after voter approval. Requires a district to make an evaluation for safety improvements for the new site before issuing bonds. Takes effect on passage.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Need for flexibility in selection of school construction sites after bond approval. Maintaining site evaluation for safety improvements before issuing bonds Naming of construction location in bond ballot title

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:**

None.

## **BACKGROUND:**

School districts may have access to a preferred alternative site after voter approval of a construction bond. However, no evaluation for safety improvements will have been done prior to the election. This is especially applicable for districts with a multi-year construction and bonding program financed by one bond vote.
