**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Modifies conditions under which parent or guardian may give alcohol to person under 21 years of age. Creates exception for wine provided during a religious rite or service.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

• Provisions of the measure

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Specifies conflict amendment combining the Act with SB 227 if SB 227 is passed.

**BACKGROUND:** HB 2246B establishes that a parent or guardian may provide alcohol to an underage person only if they are accompanying the underage person and they are in a private residence. In all other instances, a person in control of property may not allow any person under age 21 to consume alcohol on the property and may not allow someone who is underage and who has consumed alcohol to remain on the property.
