WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Modifies crime of sex abuse in the third degree to include intentionally propelling a dangerous substance at another person. Clarifies that act must be done with intent to gratify the sexual desire of offender.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Categorizes crime of propelling a dangerous substance at another with intent to sexually gratify as sex abuse in the third degree, a Class A misdemeanor.

BACKGROUND: Under HB 2478B, "dangerous substance" is defined as blood, urine, semen or feces. Under current law, if a person intentionally threw these substances on another person they could be charged with harassment, a Class B misdemeanor.
