## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Under this measure, the crime of endangering an aircraft in the second degree would constitute a Class A misdemeanor. This measure also grants full policing authority to the Port of Portland. Currently, the Port of Portland has a policing unit. However, under statute, the officers only have authority within the airport and adjoining property.
