WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires elected officials and state agencies that provide electronic information to the public to disclose any embedded tracking features. Exempts information obtained through use of electronic tracking features from public records disclosure requirements.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Embedded tracking features allow senders of electronic information to determine when communication sent via e-mail was opened, to whom it was forwarded, and whether any contained links were activated, among other information. HB 2527 requires elected officials and state agencies to disclose the presence of any such tracking features contained in electronic communication.
