REVENUE: No revenue impact

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Abolishes the Oregon Fryer Commission. Provides for distribution of commission account balance to commission members. Declares an emergency and takes effect upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Commission's original purpose was primarily for marketing, which is no longer a priority ٠
- Growers need to put their money toward other purposes; feed and propane in particular

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Clarifies disbursements that may be owed to growers for payout over a one-year period.

BACKGROUND: The Oregon Fryer Commission has existed for more than fifty years to promote Oregon-grown frying chickens. Abolishment is sought because the market and the economy have changed since the Commission's inception that obviate its purpose.
