WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Provides emergency unemployment insurance benefits to individuals who have exhausted regular benefits. Declares an emergency, effective upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Referral to House Committee on Rules

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: HB 2992 defines the unemployment insurance (UI) benefit "emergency benefit period" as beginning on May 2^{nd} , 2009 and ending on August 15, 2009. Individuals can qualify for UI benefits if they have exhausted regular benefits on the week of December 6^{th} , 2008 or later, is not eligible for any other employment benefits such as any federal benefit extensions, and otherwise continues to meet the statutory eligibility requirements.
