WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows amendment of local ordinance, rule or other local law regulating manufactured dwelling park closures until January 1, 2010, if amendment does not reduce rights of tenants. Declares an emergency; effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Preemption
- Affected localities
- Manufactured dwelling park closures

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The passage of 2007 legislation regulating manufactured dwelling park closures created some conflicts with local ordinances in six jurisdictions. House Bill 3085A grants a limited time for those jurisdictions to address regulatory conflicts and, if necessary, amend local law.
