REVENUE: No revenue impact

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes Department of Corrections (DOC) to lease to the Department of Human Services (DHS) all or part of real property known as the Milliron Road Site. Permits DHS to build, own, and operate on such property a hospital to provide diagnosis and evaluation, medical care, detoxification, social services, rehabilitation and other services to individuals committed to DHS or the state hospital. Authorizes departments to enter into agreement transferring hospital ownership from DHS to DOC. Declares an emergency; effective upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Role of community-based mental health offices
- Need to be referred to Ways & Means

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Replaces the measure.

BACKGROUND: Senate Bill 166A clarifies DOC's statutory authority to lease land to the DHS and to allow DHS to build and operate a state hospital on the Milliron Road Site south of Junction City. The measure also allows DHS, in the future, to transfer ownership of state hospital buildings to DOC.
