WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Increases amount below which Department of Agriculture may refuse to issue a payment refund.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Staff time required to calculate and process automatic refunds
- Crediting overpayment toward future license or permit renewal ٠
- Depositing overpayments into an account for unclaimed property

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Department of Agriculture (the Department) reports that it takes approximately one hour of staff time to process a refund for an overpayment, and that the cost of processing a refund is approximately \$31.45. The Department currently automatically refunds overpayments of \$5.00 or more. Senate Bill 187 would increase that threshold amount to \$25.00. The Department also reports that any refund, in any amount, is processed upon receipt of a written request.
