## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The current threshold amount for the Department of Agriculture to refuse to issue a payment refund is \$5. Senate Bill 187 would increase that amount to \$25.

The department reports that the cost of processing a refund is approximately \$31.45. The department also reports that refunds, in any amount, will be processed pursuant to a request in writing.
