REVENUE: No revenue impact

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes insurer to pay cash dividends to enrollees who participate in approved program to promote healthy behaviors.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Definition of "healthy behaviors" •
- Concerns about the creation of additional bureaucracy ٠
- Compliance with Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act regulations
- Outcome based rather than participation based •
- Small employer market and potential lower premiums ٠

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Eliminates the requirement for insurer reporting, but allows for voluntary participation. Clarifies the enrollee's participation in a program that "promotes healthy behaviors."

BACKGROUND: Healthy behaviors are generally defined as participating in constructive behaviors that encourage fitness, healthy eating and other activities that are beneficial to good health. Senate Bill 679 A authorizes insurers to pay dividends in the form of cash to enrollees who participate in a program approved by the insurer that promotes healthy behaviors.
