# EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently, the Oregon Student Assistance Commission (OSAC) offers to nurse educators in Oregon loan repayment programs, administered by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Nursing Student Loan and Health Education Assistance Loan Program. Senate Bill 701-A creates the Nursing Faculty Loan Repayment Program to provide loan repayments on behalf of nurse educators at nursing schools in Oregon who have earned a master's or doctoral degree from an accredited nursing education program. As the agency responsible for administering the loan program, OSAC is directed to adopt rules in consultation with the Oregon State Board of Nursing and the Oregon Center for Nursing to establish criteria for participation in the Nursing Faculty Loan Repayment Program.
