WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Congratulates Coach Daniel J. Miles and Oregon Institute of Technology on success of the school's men's basketball program over many seasons.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Coach Daniel "Danny" Miles has served as the Oregon Institute of Technology's (OIT) men's basketball coach for 38 seasons. During that time, Coach Miles led the Hustlin' Owls to NAIA Division II National Championships in 2004 and 2008. Coach Miles entered the 2008-2009 season with an 847-362 win/loss record and is ranked seventh in wins in the history of men's collegiate basketball, at all levels, in the United States. Coach Miles was the recipient of the Southern Oregon University Distinguished Alumnus Award in 2005, inducted into the NAIA Hall of Fame in 2001, the Oregon Sports Hall of Fame in 1996, and named National Basketball Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2008.
