Mandated by the Governor in 1989 to improve a struggling economy, the plan set three goals and recommended strategies to achieve these goals. The plan was updated 1997 (Oregon Shines II) and again in 2008 (Oregon Shines III). The plan also created the Oregon Benchmarks to measure progress. The Governor and the Legislative Assembly created the Oregon Progress Board to organize the efforts of the state partners and align their work with the overall plan.
