LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE: This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

COMMENTS: The bill directs the Department of Revenue (DOR) to develop and administer at tax amnesty program and to publicize the program through appropriate outreach and media activities; allows DOR to prescribe forms, instructions and host public meetings to maximize public participation in the program; prescribes taxpayer participation requirements and conditions; directs DOR to offer installment payment agreements if the Department concludes that the agreement will facilitate efficient collection of the outstanding tax liability; directs DOR to waive all applicable penalties for taxpayers who full comply with the amnesty program; establishes Tax Amnesty Fund and directs that moneys received by DOR from the tax amnesty program be deposited in the fund; allows DOR to recover program costs up to \$1 million; and, directs DOR to certify to the Emergency Board the costs incurred to administer the program.

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Revenue Committee to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. DOR anticipates that the administration of the program will be within the \$1 million allowable cost recovery amount. Estimates on personal service, services and supplies and other expenditures are still being prepared by the Department. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
