GOVERNOR'S BUDGET: This bill is anticipated by the Governor's recommended budget.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE: This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

COMMENTS: ORS 291.055(1)(e) requires all new state agency fees or fee increases adopted after July 1 of any odd-numbered year to be rescinded on July 1 unless authorized by enabling legislation setting forth the approved fees. This bill provides the enabling legislation necessary to approve the proposed fee increases by the Oregon Board of Dentistry.

The additional revenue generated by these fee increases will pay for FBI criminal background checks and subscriptions to national healthcare practitioner databases that will automatically notify the Board if one of its licensees is the subject of official action in another state. The fee changes are outlined below.
