## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows Oregon Youth Authority to require fingerprints of applicant to operate youth offender foster home or member of applicant's household for purpose of criminal records check.

2	Relating to fingerprints required by Oregon Youth Authority; creating new provisions; and amending

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. ORS 420A.021 is amended to read:
6	420A.021. For the purpose of requesting a state or nationwide criminal records check under ORS
7	181.534, the Oregon Youth Authority may require the fingerprints of a person who:
8	(1) Is employed or applying for employment by the youth authority; $[or]$
9	(2) Provides services or seeks to provide services to the youth authority as a contractor, vendor
10	or volunteer; or
11	(3) Is an applicant to operate a youth offender foster home, as defined in ORS 420.888
12	or who is a member of the applicant's household.
13	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 420A.021 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to
14	persons submitting applications on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
15
