Delete lines 4 through 28 of the printed bill and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. ORS 811.507 is amended to read: 3 "811.507. (1) As used in this section: "(a) 'Hands-free accessory' means an attachment or built-in feature for or an addition 4  $\mathbf{5}$ to a mobile communication device, whether or not permanently installed in a motor vehicle, that when used allows a person to maintain both hands on the steering wheel. 6 7 "(b) 'Mobile communication device' means a text messaging device or a wireless, two-way communication device designed to receive and transmit voice or text communication. 8 9 "[(1)] (2) A person [under 18 years of age] commits the offense of operating a motor vehicle while 10 using a mobile communication device if the person, while operating a motor vehicle on a highway, 11 uses a mobile communication device. [and the person holds:] "[(a) A provisional driver license issued under ORS 807.065;] 1213 "[(b) A special student driver permit issued under ORS 807.230; or] 14 "[(c) An instruction driver permit issued under ORS 807.280.] "[(2) For purposes of this section, 'mobile communication device' means a text messaging device 15 16 or a wireless, two-way communication device designed to receive and transmit voice or text communi-17 cation.] 18 "(3) This section does not apply: 19 "(a) To a person who is summoning medical or other emergency help if no other person in the 20 vehicle is capable of summoning help; [or] 21(b) To a person using a mobile communication device for the purpose of farming or agricultural 22operations[.]; "(c) To a person operating an ambulance or emergency vehicle; 23 24 "(d) To a person 18 years of age or older who is using a hands-free accessory; 25"(e) To a person operating a motor vehicle while providing public safety services or 26 emergency services as a volunteer; 27"(f) To a person operating a motor vehicle while acting in the scope of the person's em-28ployment as a public safety officer, as defined in ORS 348.270; 29"(g) To a person operating a motor vehicle in the scope of the person's employment if operation of the motor vehicle is necessary for the person's job; 30 31 "(h) To a person activating or deactivating the mobile communication device or a func-32tion of the device; or (i) To a person using a function of the mobile communication device that allows for only 33 34 one-way voice communication while the person is: 35"(A) Operating a motor vehicle in the scope of the person's employment;

1 "(B) Providing transit services to persons with disabilities or to senior citizens; or

2 "(C) Participating in public safety or emergency service activities.

- 3 "[(4) Notwithstanding ORS 810.410, a police officer may enforce this provision only as a secondary
- 4 action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected traffic violation or some other
  5 offense.]
- 6 "[(5)] (4) The offense described in this section, operating a motor vehicle while using a mobile
- 7 communication device, is a Class D traffic violation.".
