## House Bill 2455

Sponsored by Representative MAURER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows districts to offer benefit plans other than benefit plans provided by Oregon Educators Benefit Board.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to Oregon Educators Benefit Board; creating new provisions; and repealing ORS 243.886
and section 16, chapter 7, Oregon Laws 2007.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 243.860 to 6 243.886.

7 SECTION 2. (1) A district may provide or contract for benefit plans provided and ad-

8 ministered by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board or may provide or contract for benefit

9 plans other than benefit plans provided and administered by the board.

(2) Eligible employees may participate in benefit plans provided and administered by the
board or benefit plans provided or contracted for by a district.

12 <u>SECTION 3.</u> A district that offers a benefit plan provided and administered by the Oregon

13 Educators Benefit Board may not offer its own benefit plan until the expiration of the benefit

## 14 plan provided and administered by the board.

15 **SECTION 4. (1) ORS 243.886 is repealed.** 

16 (2) Section 16, chapter 7, Oregon Laws 2007, as amended by section 7, chapter 39, Oregon
17 Laws 2008, is repealed.
