4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 171.275 is amended to read:

6 171.275. (1) Each biennium, the Legislative Counsel, under the direction of the Legislative 7 Counsel Committee, shall publish and distribute the Oregon Revised Statutes, including an index and 8 annotations.

9 (2) Each biennium, the Legislative Counsel shall solicit bids for the printing of the 10 Oregon Revised Statutes.

11 [(2)] (3) The Legislative Counsel Committee shall establish policies for the revision, clarification, 12 classification, arrangement, codification, annotation, indexing, printing, binding, publication, copy-

13 righting, sale and distribution of the publications referred to in subsection (1) of this section.

14 [(3)] (4) The Legislative Counsel Committee shall establish the charges necessary to recover the 15 costs of publishing the materials sold and distributed under this section.

16 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 171.275 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to all 17 editions of the Oregon Revised Statutes that follow the 2009 Edition of the Oregon Revised 18 Statutes.
