SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to adopt rules setting fees payable by labor organizations that receive amounts deducted from salary or wages of certain public employees. Sets January 1, 2010, operative date. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to payroll deductions for payment to labor organizations; creating new provisions; amend-2

ing ORS 292.055; and declaring an emergency. 3

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. ORS 292.055 is amended to read:

292.055. (1) Upon receipt of [the request in writing of] a written request from a state officer 6 7 or employee [so to do], the state official authorized to disburse funds in payment of the salary or 8 wages of [such] the state officer or employee [each month] shall deduct each month from the salary 9 or wages of [such] the officer or employee the amount of money indicated in [such] the request, for payment [thereof] to a designated labor organization as [the same is] defined in ORS 243.650. 10

(2) [Such state official each month shall pay such amount so deducted to any such labor organ-11 12 ization so designated to receive it] Each month, the state official shall pay the amount deducted 13to the labor organization designated to receive the amount.

(3) Unless there is a contract to the contrary, upon receipt of [the request in writing of such] **a** 14 written request from the officer or employee [so to do, such], the state official shall cease making 1516 [such] **the** deductions and payments.

(4) In addition to making [such] deductions and payments to any labor organization certified 1718 under the rules of the Employment Relations Board as representatives of employees in a bargaining 19 unit, any department, board, commission, bureau, institution or other agency of the state shall make 20 deductions for and payments to noncertified, yet bona fide, labor organizations, if requested to do 21so by officers and employees in that department, board, commission, bureau, institution[,] or other 22state agency, and for so long as the requests are not revoked. [No] Deductions for and payments to 23any labor organization under this section [shall be deemed] are not an unfair labor practice under 24 ORS 243.672.

25(5) Upon receipt from the Oregon Department of Administrative Services of a copy of a valid 26 fair-share agreement in a collective bargaining unit, the state official authorized to disburse funds 27in payment of the salary or wages of the employees in [such] the unit [each month] shall deduct each 28month from the salary or wages of the employees covered by the agreement the in-lieu-of-dues 29 payment stated in the agreement and pay [such] the amount to the labor organization that is a

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1 party to the agreement in the same manner as deducted dues are paid to a labor organization. 2. [Such] The deduction and payment shall continue for the life of the agreement.

2 [Such] The deduction and payment shall continue for the life of the agreement.

3 (6)(a) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall adopt rules establishing
4 a fee to be paid by labor organizations receiving payments under this section.

5 (b) The labor organization shall pay the fee to the state official, department, board, 6 commission, bureau, institution or other agency of the state making payments to labor or-7 ganizations under this section according to a schedule set by the Oregon Department of 8 Administrative Services.

9 (c) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall set the fee in an amount 10 sufficient to cover the cost to be incurred by the state official, department, board, commis-11 sion, bureau, institution or other agency of the state in administering this section.

12 (d) Fees collected under this section shall be deposited in the General Fund.

13 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The amendments to ORS 292.055 by section 1 of this 2009 Act become 14 operative January 1, 2010, and apply to amounts deducted from the salary or wages of offi-15 cers or employees on or after January 1, 2010.

16(2) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services and any state official, department, board, commission, bureau, institution or other agency of the state may take any action 17 prior to January 1, 2010, that is necessary to allow the Oregon Department of Administrative 18 Services and any other state official, department, board, commission, bureau, institution or 19 agency of the state to exercise, on and after January 1, 2010, all the duties, functions and 20powers conferred on the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and any other state 2122official, department, board, commission, bureau, institution or agency of the state by the 23amendments to ORS 292.055 by section 1 of this 2009 Act.

24 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 25 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 26 on its passage.

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
