SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits employer from including residency pay differential in wages or salaries of employees that is based on cities, counties or states in which employees reside.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to pay differentials based on residency. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 653.010 to 4 653.261. 5 6 SECTION 2. (1) An employer may not employ two or more individuals to perform the $\mathbf{7}$ same work and pay wages or a salary that includes a residency pay differential. 8 (2) The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries may adopt rules to imple-9 ment the provisions of subsection (1) of this section. (3) As used in this section, "residency pay differential" means an addition to or deduction 10 from the wages or salary of an employee that is attributable to the city, county or state in 11 12which the employee resides.
