House Bill 2757

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Legislative Assembly to include appropriations exceeding \$5 million in separate bills. Exempts appropriations for state agency budgets and expenditure limitations.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to appropriation bills.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "state agency" means every state officer, board, 5 commission, department, institution, branch or agency of the state government, whose costs 6 are paid wholly or in part from funds held in the State Treasury.

7 (2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, the Legislative Assembly shall

8 include an appropriation for the current expenses of the state in an amount exceeding \$5
9 million in a bill that contains no other appropriations.

10 (3) Subsection (2) of this section does not apply to:

11 (a) Appropriations made for the biennial budget of a state agency; or

12 (b) Expenditure limitations.
