A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to United States Armed Forces.

3 Whereas Oregonians have a long-standing tradition of serving in the Armed Forces of the United

4 States, with thousands of Oregonians giving their lives in defense of this country; and

5 Whereas the contributions of Oregon military personnel have been vital to maintaining the 6 freedoms and way of life that Americans cherish; and

7 Whereas it is vital to raise awareness of the sacrifices that our brave men and women in uni-

form have made in the past and continue to make in order to defend the United States Constitution
and to preserve the liberties that enrich this great nation; and

10 Whereas it is important to recognize and honor the sacrifices, support and dedication of the 11 families of the men and women who have served; and

12 Whereas Oregonians recognize the importance of maintaining a strong, well-equipped, well-

educated and well-trained military to safeguard freedoms and maintain peacekeeping missionsaround the world; now, therefore,
