SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Increases punishment for second and subsequent convictions of unlawful possession of firearms. Punishes by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.] Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to classify crime of felon in possession of

firearm in certain circumstances as specific category crimes of sentencing guidelines grid.

2 Relating to unlawful possession of a firearm.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the Oregon Criminal

5 Justice Commission shall classify felon in possession of a firearm as described in ORS 166.270

6 as crime category 3 of the sentencing guidelines grid of the commission.

7 (2) The commission shall classify felon in possession of a firearm as described in ORS

8 166.270 as crime category 8 of the sentencing guidelines grid of the commission if the person

9 has been convicted of a person felony as defined in the rules of the commission.

10 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to offenses committed on or after the ef 11 fective date of this 2009 Act.
