SUMMARY

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Prohibits [assistant attorneys general and] deputy district attorneys from striking.

2 Relating to strikes by certain public attorneys; amending ORS 243.736.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 243.736 is amended to read:

5 243.736. (1) It is unlawful for any of the following public employees to strike or recognize a 6 picket line of a labor organization while in the performance of official duties:

7 (a) Deputy district attorneys;

8 [(a)] (b) Emergency telephone worker;

9 [(b)] (c) Employee of the Oregon Youth Authority who has custody, control or supervision of 10 youth offenders;

11 [(*c*)] (**d**) Firefighter;

12 [(d)] (e) Guard at a correctional institution or mental hospital;

13 [(e)] (f) Parole and probation officer who supervises adult offenders; and

14 [(f)] (g) Police officer.

(2) As used in this section, "emergency telephone worker" means a person whose official focal duties are receiving information through a 9-1-1 emergency reporting system under ORS 401.710 to 401.816, relaying the information to public or private safety agencies or dispatching emergency equipment or personnel in response to the information.
