SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to prepare and submit to Legislative Assembly annual report containing list of employers with employees receiving public assistance, including supplemental nutrition assistance program benefits.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reports prepared by the Department of Human Services.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** (1) As used in this section, "employer" includes:

5 (a) An employing unit as defined in ORS 657.020;

6 (b) A trade or industry;

7 (c) A type of business, including but not limited to retail sales, fast food restaurants and

8 quick printing services; and

9 (d) Franchisees doing business in this state under a single common name.

10 (2) The Department of Human Services shall annually prepare a report that includes:

11 (a)(A) A list of the 40 employers doing business in this state with the greatest number

12 of employees who receive medical assistance in Oregon; and

(B) A list of the 40 employers doing business in this state with the greatest number of
employees who receive supplemental nutrition assistance program benefits in Oregon;

(b) The total number of employees in Oregon per employer listed in paragraph (a) of this
subsection;

(c) Whether each employer listed under paragraph (a) of this subsection is unionized or
nonunion; and

(d) The amount of medical assistance and food stamp benefits provided to all employed
Oregonians.

(3) The department shall adopt all rules and procedures necessary to implement sub section (2) of this section.

(4) By March 1 of each year, the department shall submit the report described in sub section (2) of this section to the Legislative Assembly in the manner described in ORS 192.245
and shall make the report available on the department's website.

26 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Department of Human Services shall make the first report described in 27 section 1 of this 2009 Act available by March 1, 2011.
