House Bill 3147

Sponsored by Representative J SMITH; Senator MONNES ANDERSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Authorizes urban renewal agencies to award grants to assist persons relocating within and outside urban renewal area.

Directs Director of Department of Revenue to adopt rules establishing eligibility criteria and grant award process.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to urban renewal.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) In exercising powers granted under ORS 457.170 and 457.180, an urban 5 renewal agency may award grants to assist in relocating persons living in an urban renewal 6 area.

7 (2) Grants under subsection (1) of this section may be awarded:

8 (a) To persons relocating within the urban renewal area for the costs of relocation,
9 housing and infrastructure services;

10 (b) To persons relocating to a zone of impact outside the urban renewal area for the 11 costs of relocation, housing and infrastructure services; and

(c) To service providers for the costs of providing infrastructure services to relocated
 persons.

(3) The Director of the Department of Revenue shall adopt rules necessary to carry out
 the purposes of this section, including rules that establish:

16 (a) Criteria for eligibility for grants under this section;

17 (b) Criteria for designating an area outside an urban renewal area a zone of impact; and

18 (c) The process for applying for and awarding grants.

19 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to urban renewal plans adopted or sub-20 stantially amended on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.
