House Bill 3210

Sponsored by Representatives BEYER, C EDWARDS; Senator WALKER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Clarifies and expands duties of Oregon Virtual School District. Requires curriculum that provides at least one-half of program of instruction online to be provided through Oregon Virtual School District.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the Oregon Virtual School District; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 329.840. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. ORS 329.840 is amended to read: 4

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329.840. (1) [There is created] The Oregon Virtual School District is created within the Depart- $\mathbf{5}$

ment of Education. The purpose of the Oregon Virtual School District is to provide the resources and oversight for quality and comprehensive online courses to kindergarten through grade 12 7

8 public school students. Any curriculum that provides at least one-half of a program of in-

struction online must be provided through the Oregon Virtual School District. 9

(2) For the purpose of providing the resources and oversight of the Oregon Virtual School 10 District, the Superintendent of Public Instruction may enter into a contract with a single 11 12 entity that is an education service district, a school district or another appropriate public 13or private entity.

14 [(2)] (3)(a) The Oregon Virtual School District shall [provide] establish curricula for online courses that meet academic content standards as defined in ORS 329.007 and meet other criteria 15 16 adopted by the State Board of Education. Courses must meet the credit requirements of this 17state to ensure that courses are recognized for credit by school districts.

(b) Evidence of successful completion of courses provided through the Oregon Virtual 18 19 School District shall be included in a student's education record.

20 (c) The Oregon Virtual School District shall conduct regular evaluations of curricula and 21online courses to ensure that the curricula and courses meet the requirements for credit as 22described in this subsection.

23(4) The Oregon Virtual School District shall ensure that any person who teaches an online course [must be properly] through the Oregon Virtual School District is licensed by the Teacher 24 Standards and Practices Commission [or registered as required by ORS 338.135 and 342.173 for 25 26 a person employed by a school district or public charter school].

(5)(a) All school districts and public charter schools [may] must allow students to access the 27 online courses offered by the Oregon Virtual School District. 28

(b) School districts shall provide credit to a student who satisfactorily completes a course 29 30 provided through the Oregon Virtual School District if the course meets the requirements for credit as described in subsection (3) of this section. 31

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1 (6) School districts, in collaboration with the Oregon Virtual School District, shall de-2 termine whether enrollment in the Oregon Virtual School District by a student is appropri-3 ate and shall ensure that a student is adequately placed in courses provided through the 4 Oregon Virtual School District.

5 (7)(a) A school district shall ensure that each student enrolled with the Oregon Virtual 6 School District has access to and use of a computer and appropriate Internet service for the 7 purpose of effectively accessing the education program through the Oregon Virtual School 8 District.

9 (b) A school district shall provide a computer and Internet service to a student at no cost 10 or at a reduced cost, as appropriate, if the costs of the computer and Internet service cause 11 a severe hardship, as determined by a school district based on policies adopted by the district 12 school board for the school district.

[(3)] (8) The Superintendent of Public Instruction, on behalf of the Oregon Virtual School
District, may contract with [education service districts, school districts, public charter schools, community colleges, state institutions of higher education or any other public entity] any public or private
entity to provide online courses through the Oregon Virtual School District.

[(4)] (9) Statutes and rules that apply to other school districts do not apply to the Oregon Virtual School District except as provided under this section or by rule of the State Board of Education. The Oregon Virtual School District is not considered a school district for purposes of apportionment of the State School Fund and the department may not receive a direct apportionment under ORS 327.008 from the State School Fund for the Oregon Virtual School District.

[(5)] (10) The board may adopt the rules necessary for the administration of the Oregon Virtual School District and shall adopt rules to establish:

(a) The procedure and criteria to be used for the selection of online courses to be offered
through the Oregon Virtual School District;

(b) The qualifications of students who may access online courses through the Oregon VirtualSchool District;

(c) The number of credits for which students may access online courses through the Oregon
Virtual School District; and

30 (d) The student-to-teacher ratio for online courses offered through the Oregon Virtual School
31 District.

32 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The provisions of ORS 329.840, as amended by section 1 of this 2009 Act, that 33 require certain online curricula to be provided through the Oregon Virtual School District 34 apply only to online curricula that are provided as the result of a contract or charter that 35 is entered into or extended on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.

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
