House Bill 3258

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Establishes medical education loan program for new primary care physicians in Oregon. Creates Primary Care Medical Education Loan Fund. Continuously appropriates moneys in fund to Oregon Student Assistance Commission for purposes of awarding medical education loans.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to medical education for primary care physicians; and appropriating money. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) In addition to any other financial aid provided by law, the Oregon Student 4 Assistance Commission may award loans to qualified applicants, from the fund established $\mathbf{5}$ in section 5 of this 2009 Act, to assist in financing the cost of a program of study leading to 6 the degree of Doctor of Medicine or to the degree of Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine. The 7 commission may award loans under this section in an amount equal to 50 percent of the 8 medical school's standard tuition and fees. 9 (2) The commission shall: 10 (a) Develop criteria for the preparation of applications and procedures for the sub-11 mission, evaluation, priority selection and award of loans provided for in sections 1 to 5 of 12 this 2009 Act; 13(b) Determine the number and amount of loans and loan renewals; and 14 (c) Adopt rules necessary to implement sections 1 to 5 of this 2009 Act. 15 SECTION 2. (1) A person is eligible for a loan under section 1 of this 2009 Act if the 16 17person is: 18 (a) A resident of this state; 19 (b) Accepted for enrollment or a student in good standing in the professional medical 20 program at an accredited medical school or accredited school of osteopathic medicine located 21in the United States; and 22(c) Willing to make a commitment to practice primary care medicine in this state. 23(2) A person applying for a loan under section 1 of this 2009 Act shall: (a) Submit an application to the Oregon Student Assistance Commission on a form pro-2425vided by the commission; and 26 (b) Agree in writing to practice primary care medicine for five years in this state. SECTION 3. A loan awarded under section 1 of this 2009 Act is renewable annually for 27 each year the student is enrolled in medical school or for a total of four years, whichever is 28 less. The Oregon Student Assistance Commission shall renew a loan upon application by the 29 30 recipient if the commission finds that the recipient: (1) Has successfully completed the required work for the preceding academic year; 31

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1 (2) Is a student in good standing; and

2 (3) Is a resident of this state.

3 <u>SECTION 4.</u> (1) A person receiving a loan under section 1 of this 2009 Act is not required
 4 to repay the loan if the person practices primary care medicine in this state for five years.

5 (2) A person receiving a loan under section 1 of this 2009 Act who fails to complete the 6 required course of study shall repay the amount received to the Oregon Student Assistance 7 Commission plus 10 percent interest on the unpaid balance, accrued from the date the loan 8 was granted.

9 (3) A person receiving a loan under section 1 of this 2009 Act who completes the required 10 course of study but fails to fulfill the obligations required for the loan shall repay the amount 11 received to the commission plus 10 percent interest on the unpaid balance, accrued from the 12 date the loan was granted. Additionally, a penalty fee equal to 25 percent of the amount 13 received shall be assessed against the person. No interest accrues on the penalty.

(4) The commission shall deposit moneys received under this section into the Primary
 Care Medical Education Loan Fund.

(5) The commission may waive any interest or penalty assessed under subsection (2) or
(3) of this section in cases of undue hardship.

18 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) The Primary Care Medical Education Loan Fund is established in the 19 State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. The Primary Care Medical 20 Education Loan Fund consists of moneys received by the Oregon Student Assistance Com-21 mission from any public or private source for the purpose of awarding student loans as 22 provided in section 1 of this 2009 Act.

(2) Moneys in the Primary Care Medical Education Loan Fund may be invested in the
 same manner as the Oregon Student Assistance Fund established under ORS 348.570. Inter est earned by the Primary Care Medical Education Loan Fund shall be credited to the fund.

(3) All moneys received by the Oregon Student Assistance Commission under sections 1
 to 5 of this 2009 Act, including repayments, interest and penalties, are continuously appro priated to the Oregon Student Assistance Commission for the purpose of awarding loans
 under section 1 of this 2009 Act.

30 <u>SECTION 6.</u> Section 7 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 316.

31 <u>SECTION 7.</u> There shall be subtracted from federal taxable income the amount of a loan 32 from the Primary Care Medical Education Loan Fund that is not required to be repaid as 33 provided under sections 1 to 5 of this 2009 Act.

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
