House Bill 3277

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to conduct study of addition of ethanol to gasoline. Requires department to report to Legislative Assembly. Sunsets January 2, 2012.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to ethanol.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall conduct a study on the 5 consequences of the addition of ethanol to gasoline.

6 (2) The study must focus on any new scientific studies that show any harmful effects of

7 the addition of ethanol to gasoline as well as scientific studies that show the beneficial effect

- 8 of the addition of ethanol to gasoline.
- 9 (3) The study must also examine the possibility that ethanol may be harmful to marine 10 engines and fuel lines.
- 11 (4) The department shall report the results of its study to the Seventy-sixth Legislative
- 12 Assembly on or before March 1, 2011, in the manner required under ORS 192.245.
- 13 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2009 Act is repealed on January 2, 2012.
