House Bill 3308

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Department of Human Services to require group care facility to have staff, security and capacity to accept at least one person on outpatient commitment.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 Relating to residential care for individuals on outpatient commitment; creating new provisions; and 2 amending ORS 443.205. 3

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. In addition to any other requirements established by rule, the Department 5 6 of Human Services shall require a domiciliary care facility that is a group care facility, as a condition of licensing or certification, to have adequate staffing, security and capacity to 7 8 accept for admission at least one individual who is on outpatient commitment under ORS

SECTION 2. ORS 443.205 is amended to read: 10

443.205. As used in ORS 443.215 and 443.225 and section 1 of this 2009 Act, "domiciliary care 11 12 facilities" means facilities providing residential care to adults, including adult foster homes, group 13care facilities or residential treatment, training or care facilities, established, contracted for or operated by the Department of Human Services. 14

SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to licenses for group care facilities issued 15or renewed by the Department of Human Services on or after the effective date of this 2009 16 17 Act.

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
