

# A-Engrossed House Bill 5020

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Judicial Department for biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Judicial Department.

Limits biennial expenditures by Judicial Department from federal funds.

*[Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.]*

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to financial administration of the Judicial Department; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Judicial Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the General Fund, the following amounts to be used for payment of expenses of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court, State Court Administrator and trial courts for the following purposes:

- (1) Operations..... \$274,239,126
- (2) Mandated payments ..... \$ 13,902,620
- (3) Debt service ..... \$ 7,657,794

**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$46,512,559 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Judicial Department.

**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$869,835 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Judicial Department.

**SECTION 4.** This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect July 1, 2009.
