SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to ______ for biennial expenses.] [Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____]

[Limits biennial expenditures of _______ from federal funds.] Changes amount of appropriations and expenditure limits for specified agencies and programs for biennium ending June 30, 2009.

Limits expenditures from specified federal funds collected or received by Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for biennium beginning July 1, 2007. Specifies that expenditures from specified federal funds received by Employment Department for unemployment insurance claims are not limited for biennium beginning July 1, 2007.

Decreases allocation of moneys from Administrative Services Economic Fund to office of Governor, Economic and Community Development Department and Problem Gambling Treatment Fund for biennium beginning July 1, 2007.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2009.

6 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 7 \$400,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for 8 payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 4, chapter 698, 9 Oregon Laws 2007, collected or received by the Department of Community Colleges and 10 Workforce Development for the Oregon Youth Conservation Corps.

(2) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, expenditures by the Employment Department
from federal funds received by the Employment Department pursuant to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, P.L. 111-5, for unemployment insurance claims are not limited.
<u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the office of the Governor established by section 22, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,
is decreased by \$13,722.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Economic and Community De velopment Department for department operations established by section 3 (1), chapter 745,
 Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$70,979.

22 <u>SECTION 8.</u> Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative 23 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Problem Gambling Treatment 24 Fund established by section 11, chapter 745, Oregon Laws 2007, for the biennium beginning 25 July 1, 2007, is decreased by \$1,994.

26 <u>SECTION 9.</u> This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 27 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect 28 on its passage.

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
