SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Board of Higher Education to determine specific capital construction projects within Oregon University System for which department may expend certain revenues, subject to expenditure limitation set by Legislative Assembly.

Directs Governor to include in budget report capital construction budget for Department of Higher Education that establishes expenditure limitation on amount department may expend from certain revenues for capital construction.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to capital construction for higher education.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2009 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 351.310 to 5 351.615.

6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Within an expenditure limitation established by law for the Department 7 of Higher Education, the State Board of Higher Education shall determine the capital con-8 struction projects within the Oregon University System for which the department may ex-9 pend proceeds from gifts, grants, donations, federal funds and other revenues, for projects 10 funded exclusively by those revenue sources, but excluding revenues from the General Fund, 11 lottery funds, bonds issued under Article XI-F(1) and Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitu-12 tion, energy loans and certificates of participation.

13 (2) The Governor shall include in the budget report required by ORS 291.216 and in the 14 capital construction program required by ORS 291.224 a capital construction budget for the 15 Department of Higher Education. The budget for the department shall establish an expendi-16 ture limitation specifying the amount that the department may expend for capital con-17 struction from gifts, grants, donations, federal funds and other revenues, but excluding 18 revenues from the General Fund, lottery funds, bonds issued under Article XI-F(1) and Ar-19 ticle XI-G of the Oregon Constitution, energy loans and certificates of participation.

20 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2009 Act first applies to the budget for the Department of 21 Higher Education prepared for the 2011-2013 biennium.
