## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 127

On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 36 through 45 and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 5. ORS 806.200 is amended to read: "806.200. (1) A person commits the offense of failure to make a future responsibility filing after 3 an accident if [the person is the owner or driver of a vehicle that is in any manner involved in an 4  $\mathbf{5}$ accident that is required to be reported under ORS 811.720 and the person does not make a future responsibility filing within 30 days after the filing of the accident report required under ORS 811.725.]: 6 "(a) The person is the owner or driver of a motor vehicle involved in an accident; 7 "(b) At the time of the accident the vehicle was operated in violation of ORS 806.010; 8 9 "(c) The person does not make a future responsibility filing within 30 days after the ac-10 cident; and "(d) The person is not exempt under ORS 806.210 from making a future responsibility 11 filing. 1213 "[(2) Exemptions from this section are established under ORS 806.210.] 14 "[(3)] (2) The employer of a driver is subject to the requirements and penalties under this section if the driver is an employee exempted from this section under ORS 806.210. If an employer is 15subject to this section, the registration of the employer's vehicles may be suspended as provided 16 17 under ORS 809.050. 18 "[(4)] (3) In addition to any other penalties under this section, violation of this section subjects 19 the violator to suspension of driving privileges as provided under ORS 809.415. 20 "[(5)] (4) The offense described in this section, failure to make a future responsibility filing after 21an accident, is a Class B traffic violation.". 22On page 3, delete lines 1 through 8. On page 5, line 12, before the period insert "or a risk retention group as defined in ORS 2324 735.305". 25
