A-Engrossed Senate Bill 19

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Allows minor 15 years of age or older to consent to diagnosis or treatment by optometrist who is acting within scope of practice for optometrist without consent of parent or guardian of minor.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to minors; amending ORS 109.640 and 109.650. 2

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 109.640 is amended to read:

5 109.640. (1) Any physician or nurse practitioner may provide birth control information and ser-

6 vices to any person without regard to the age of the person.

(2) A minor 15 years of age or older may give consent to:

(a) Except as may be provided by ORS 109.660, [a minor 15 years of age or older may give 8 9 consent to] hospital care, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment by a physician licensed by the 10 Oregon Medical Board, and dental or surgical diagnosis or treatment by a dentist licensed by the 11 Oregon Board of Dentistry, without the consent of a parent or guardian[, except as may be provided 12 by ORS 109.660] of the minor.

13 (b) [A minor 15 years of age or older may give consent to] Diagnosis and treatment by a nurse practitioner who is licensed by the Oregon State Board of Nursing under ORS 678.375 and who is 14 15acting within the scope of practice for a nurse practitioner, without the consent of a parent or 16 guardian of the minor.

(c) Diagnosis or treatment by an optometrist who is licensed by the Oregon Board of 17 18 Optometry under ORS 683.010 to 683.335 and who is acting within the scope of practice for 19 an optometrist, without the consent of a parent or guardian of the minor.

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SECTION 2. ORS 109.650 is amended to read:

21109.650. A hospital or any physician, nurse practitioner, [or] dentist or optometrist as de-22scribed in ORS 109.640 may advise the parent or parents or legal guardian of any minor of the care, 23diagnosis or treatment or the need for any treatment, without the consent of the patient, and any 24 hospital, physician, nurse practitioner, [or] dentist or optometrist is not liable for advising the parent, parents or legal guardian without the consent of the patient. 25
